



Instructions for handling, transportation, storage and use of FORTEM AAC blocks

A. Handling

- Pallet handling is done with ISIR compliant equipment: forklifts, self-elevating platforms, forklift trucks, cranes or lifting devices with suction cups/clamps.
- Handling with inclined cables or direct attachment to the protective foil is prohibited.
- In the absence of mechanized equipment, blocks can only be manually handled individually, observing the rules regarding mass handling and personal protective equipment.
- Overturning, slamming or rolling blocks is prohibited - risk of internal cracking.
- It is mandatory to lift the pallet completely - do not drag, do not push on the ground.
- Shocks, vibrations or movements on uneven surfaces are not allowed.

B. Transport

- Transport with flat, clean and continuous surfaces is used (without holes or obstacles).
- Pallets are secured with anchoring and corner straps – transport with damaged foil or unstable blocks is prohibited.
- Avoid accelerations/sudden jolts – these can cause invisible cracks or unbalance of the stack.

C. Storage

- Storage is done on flat, hard, dry platforms, preferably concrete or with a layer of compacted crushed stone.
- Do not place directly on the ground.
- A maximum of 2 pallets can be stacked, if perfect stability is ensured.
- AAC blocks are kept in the original packaging until use. After removing the foil, protect the blocks with a waterproof but ventilated tarpaulin.
- Blocks are stored in areas protected from humidity, mud, traffic or contact with other materials.
- It is prohibited to store wet products or other materials on top of AAC blocks.

D. Use

- The blocks are installed only in accordance with the current regulations for masonry.
- Special adhesive mortars for AAC are used, not classic cement mortars.
- Damaged blocks (cracks, broken corners) are removed from the installation.
- Fire reaction class: A1 (non-combustible, does not support combustion, does not emit toxic gases).

ATTENTION:

Strict compliance with these instructions is mandatory to maintain and ensure structural quality during execution.
